1. Viewing articles on the West Michigan Woodworkers Guild Facebook page are free to anyone who is interested in advancing their Woodworking Skills and Knowledge.
2. Facebook Group members are the only individuals or organizations allowed to post articles on the Guild's Facebook page.
3. To join our 'Facebook Group' an individual must first be a Guild invited individual, a student or supporter of Guild or a fully paid dues paying member of the West Michigan Woodworkers Guild based in Grand Rapids, Michigan.
4. The Guild Facebook page postings are to be solely for the sharing of woodworking related articles that could be of interest to woodworkers, the sharing of woodworking related knowledge and experiences or the sale or requests for woodworking related items or services by Guild Facebook Group members.
5. At the discretion of the West Michigan Guild Board of Directors, articles or commentary posted by a Guild Facebook Group member that are contrary to the criteria outlined in item four above may result in the removal of all that member's postings from the Guild's Facebook site plus the removal of the member from the Guild Facebook Group.
