If you have an item too big to bring to the sale, take a picture of it and bring the picture and the item's specifications to the sale so you can negotiate a 'Come See and Buy' time with a potential buyer. All items put up for Sale or Swap **MUST** be removed from the EKHS woodshop by 9:30 PM!
