



March show and tell




The hand drill is capable of a high degree of precision, especially when used with a hand drill-press jig. Charlie Pinneo brought in his to show how a hand drill can be used to drill perfectly straight holes.

Scott Moehring brought in a wooden toy that he had designed. The cool thing about this toy is that it isn't just a toy, it is also a set of building blocks. The various shapes can be disassembled and turned into anything a kid (or adult) can imagine! I have a soft spot for wood toys, but this one is just excellent in its design and playability.
