



Epoxy finish bowls - Sam Lacina

The upper bowl uses elevated stave work for the bowl body, similar to barrel staves. It was hard getting a good picture of that bowl because it was so reflective.



Marble machine - Jim Jakosh

Plywood, maple, and walnut. This marble machine has 16 working pistons that move the marbles in a never-ending cycle.



If you want to go down a strange rabbit hole in your spare time, just go on to YouTube and search for "Marble Machines." You'd be amazed the lengths some people go through to move these things in endless loops.



Violins - Mark Nickerson

Although Mark sent in some photos over our pandemic hiatus, he has continued his violin making to produce a second, and working on a third. I have a lot of patience when building my wood toys, but Mark takes it to the next level with these instruments.

25 coats of finish. Yes, 25. I am impatient with the 3rd.




Skid Loader - Steve DeVries

This is the most recent model that I have designed and written plans for. All of my model plans can be found on Amazon.com.

This one is a bit easier than my others. I really like the interchangeable wheels and treads.





Kumiko panel - Tom Howorth

Kumiko is a Japanese style of woodworking that makes decorative panels such as these but without the use of glue or nails. All of the parts are tapered and wedged into place for a friction/tension fit.

Just look at the detail of those joints!



Tom made the pattern out of basswood and a cocobolo backer. The frame was finished with milk paint. As Tom stated during the meeting, "This type of woodworking is more about the craft than the art," and I would say I agree.



Tak board - Case VanderMaas. If I'm not mistaken I believe Case carved out this board with his CNC machine.


