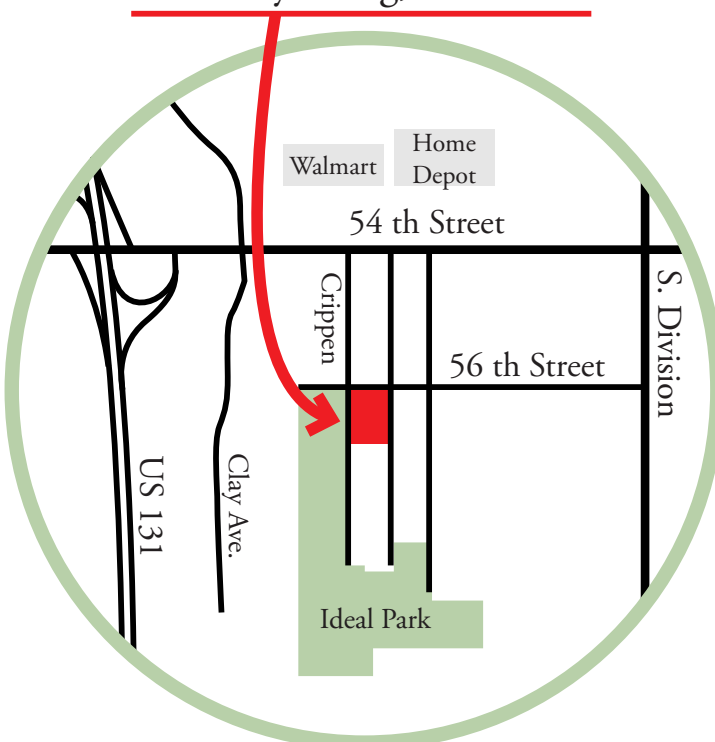

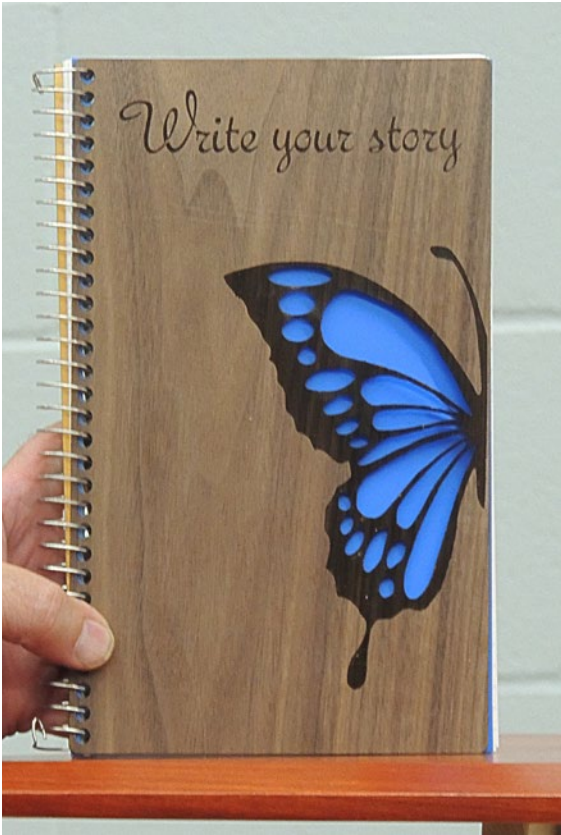

Whether I succeeded or not, and whether you agree with my philosophy or not is irrelevant at this point, the past four years of newsletters are in the history books, for good or ill.

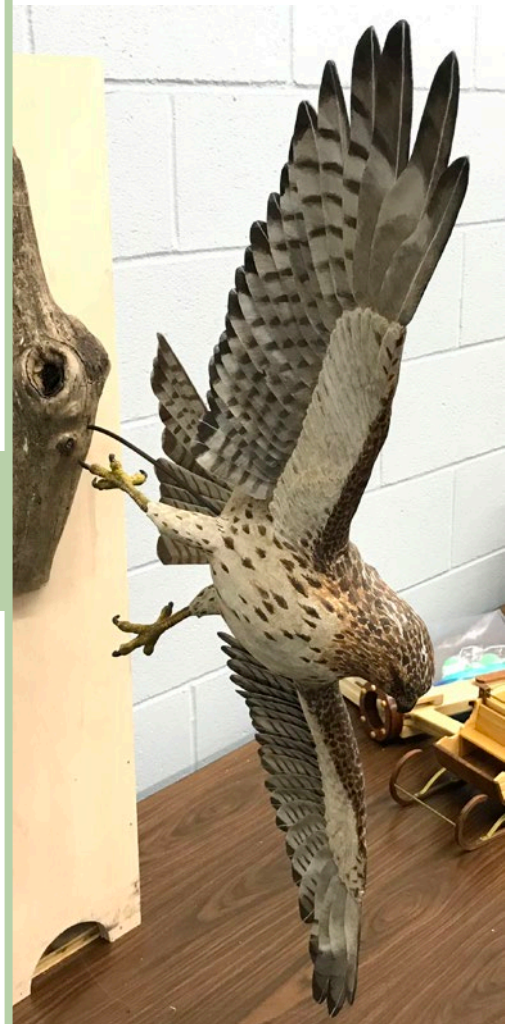
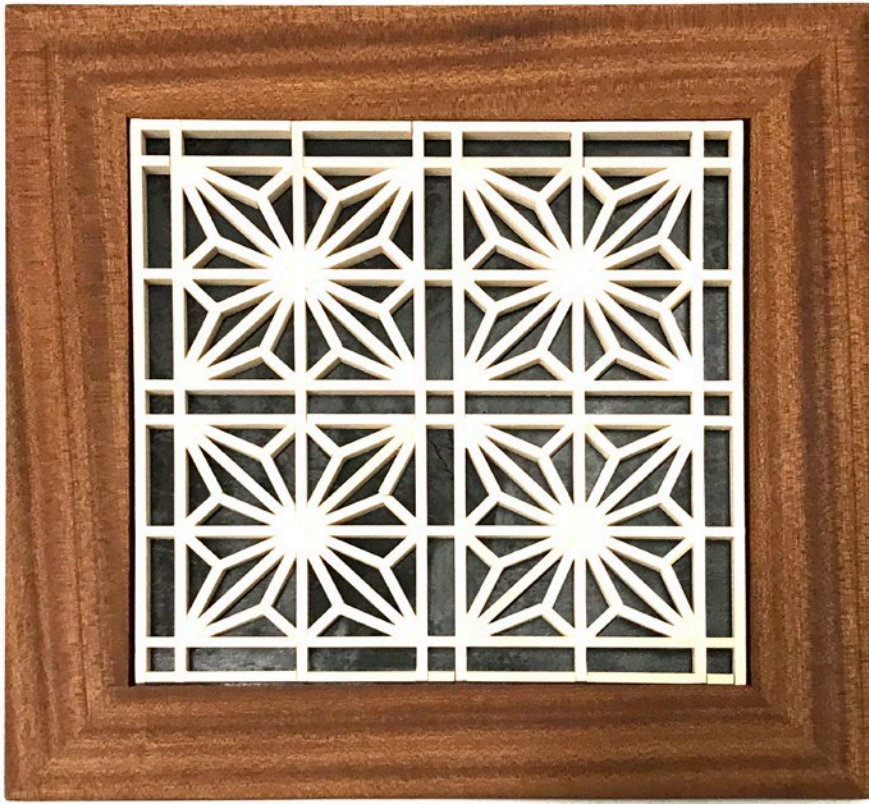
I leave it now to a new person. On the next few pages are a season-in-review of the projects from 2022-2023.

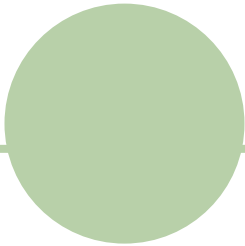

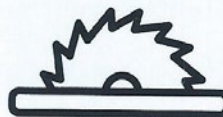
